• TMCC Grants, State Grants, and some scholarships require the FAFSA and are available to students who do not qualify for the Pell Grant.

  - Multiple Grants (Pell Grant, Silver State Opportunity Grant, Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant, TMCC Need Grant, Board of Regents GIA Grant)
  - Work Study/Student Employment Opportunities
  - Federal Direct Stafford Loans
